



**TUITION SCHEDULE AND FEES
PAYMENT POLICY 2023–2024***

We're grateful for our partnerships with families who invest so much in their students' Trinity experience. With a continuous enrollment policy, your signed contract will govern the entire term that the student attends Trinity School.

* Tuition rates are set each fall by the board of Trustees and posted on the school's website.

Returning families will have the opportunity to withdraw their student(s) during the timeframe of January 13–31, 2023. If no such notification is received, the student(s) will be enrolled for the 2023–2024 school year and families will be liable for the full cost of associated tuition.

Tuition Deposit

All families will pay a nonrefundable deposit of \$1,000 per student by February 1, 2023. The total fee is capped at a maximum of \$3,000 per family and is prorated for families receiving flexible tuition. The deposit goes directly towards the net tuition and secures your student's place.

Tuition and Fee Payment Policy

It is the policy of Trinity School to assess students for the entire academic year's tuition. The school obligates for salaries, tests, and maintenance on an annual basis. Therefore, parents have the financial obligation for full tuition whether or not the student completes the school year. Trinity School has made provision for a [Tuition Refund Plan](#) which is described on the website.

Tuition payment is made by execution of one of the following options:

- Option 1: **MONTHLY CONTINUOUS PAYMENT PLAN** that will begin April 2023 and end in March 2024 (1/12 of remaining tuition due after tuition deposit will be paid on a monthly basis; \$100 payment plan fee applies).
- Option 2: **SINGLE PAYMENT PLAN** whereby the family must pay the full tuition by April 1, 2023, for returning and newly enrolled students, in order to receive a 1% full payment discount.
- Option 3: **TWO PAYMENT PLAN** whereby the family must pay half of tuition due on April 1, 2023, and the remaining tuition due on December 1, 2023.

*Please note that hours may vary slightly on certain days depending on the school day schedule. Capacity is dependent on space restrictions.

Tuition Discounts

Families who have submitted a TADS application by the corresponding deadlines will receive notification of any flexible tuition awards alongside the continuous enrollment contract available during the withdrawal window. [Other scholarships and funding sources](#) procured according to the corresponding deadlines will also be viewable alongside the continuous enrollment contract available in the parent portal.

Trinity School offers a multi-child discount of \$750 for families with 3 children enrolled, \$1,500 for those with 4 children enrolled, and \$2,500 for those with 5 or more children enrolled.

New Student and International Student Fees

Each new application for admission has a nonrefundable fee of \$85. Should the family choose to apply for flexible tuition, the TADS application fee is an additional \$65.

The new student fee is a one-time, nonrefundable fee of \$2,000 per new student. The total fee is capped at a maximum of \$4,000 per family and is prorated for families receiving flexible tuition. The international student fee is an annual fee of \$2,500 per student. Fees are incorporated into the tuition bill and will be invoiced in accordance with the payment plan selected.

Additional fees are charged for the private lessons, off-campus education, and some consumable instructional materials (i.e., costs associated with athletics team travel, certain course packs, some Upper School textbooks, or Winterim course expenses, etc.).
